TERMS AND CONDITIONS

AIR TRANSPORTATION: Round-trip coach class on American, Delta, United or other International Air Transport Association member. Meals served in flight.

LAND TRANSPORTATION & SERVICES: By deluxe air-conditioned motor coach with professional driver, services of an English-speaking tour manager, local guides, all admission & entrance fees, transfers to and from international airports. Daily schedule per your itinerary, however we reserve the right to modify any itinerary if circumstances deem necessary.

LODGING: First-class accommodations, based upon double occupancy with limited single accommodations available at an additional charge of \$800.

MEALS: Breakfast Buffet and Dinner DAILY.

ALSO INCLUDED IN PRICE: All taxes, including airport taxes. Gratuities for tour directors, local guides, bus drivers, porters, wait staff, housekeeping and front desk personnel. Tipping will be conducted by a tour leader during the course of your tour.

NOT INCLUDED IN PRICE: The cost of obtaining your passport and visa fees to some countries, meals not included in the itinerary, wines, liquors, bottled waters, coffee or tea, personal items, laundry services, room service charges, long-distance phone calls, excess baggage, airport service charges and any sightseeing not included in the itinerary.

GROUP REQUIREMENT: The minimum number of passengers needed to assure a group's departure is 15. We reserve the right to cancel up to 30 days from departure should the total number of registered passengers be fewer than 15. If there are fewer than 15 passengers, Pilgrimage Tours will do all that is possible to assure your group's departure without having to resort to charging a supplemental fee for the group. If Pilgrimage Tours cancels, you will receive a full refund.

DEPOSIT AND FULL PAYMENT: A deposit of \$600 towards the price of the tour, per person, is required to book your reservation. The balance is to be paid in full 75 days prior to departure - July 15, 2026. Balances not paid by this date may be subject to a \$100 late payment fee. Reservations made within 60 days of departure may be subject to a higher price. Upon receipt of your registration form and deposit, a confirmation invoice along with a travel insurance flyer and other information will be mailed to you. Passport picture page copies should be included with your final payment.

INSURANCE: Trip Cancellation and Interruption Insurance is highly recommended. Cancellation fees are covered by Generali Global Assistance's policy, if your premium has been paid, your policy is in effect and the reason for your canceling is insurable. Waivers for pre-existing medical conditions are available at no additional cost, but your policy must be purchased before your final payment for the tour.

CANCELLATION FEES: Passengers not purchasing travel insurance need to be aware of the following cancellation fees. Up until 90 days prior to departure, you may cancel for any reason without penalty and receive a full refund of your deposit. The remaining cancellation fee schedule is as follows: 89-60 days = \$300; 59-45 days = 50% of tour price; 44-30 days = 75% of tour price; 29-15 days = 80% of tour price; 14 days or less = 100% of tour price.

UNDER THE SPIRITUAL DIRECTION OF FR. KEVIN PEEK

September 28, 2026 - Monday NEW YORK / PORTUGAL

Today we gather at New Yorks JFK International Airport and board our direct, overnight flight to Portugal, arriving in Lisbon the following day. Meals are served on board our transatlantic flight.

September 29, 2026 - Tuesday LISBON / FATIMA

This morning we arrive in Lisbon and meet our Pilgrimage Tours' tour manager who will remain with us until the end of our tour. We begin our pilgrimage with a panoramic tour of Lisbon, the birthplace of Saint Anthony, including a visit and celebration of Mass in the Church of Saint Anthony. Following Mass, we drive along the Tagus River where we will see the Tower of Belem and the Discoveries Monument, displaying statues of many Portuguese explorers. We will also visit Jeronimos Monastery, an impressive symbol of Portugal's power and wealth during the "Age of Discovery". Later in the afternoon we arrive in Fatima where in 1917 Mary appeared to local children and the "Miracle of the Sun" occurred. Following dinner, we participate in the evening's Candlelight Procession. Overnight in Fatima.

September 30, 2026 - Wednesday FATIMA

This morning we participate in the Stations of the Cross along the path that the shepherd children used to tend to their flock en route to the Cova da Iria where Our Lady appeared to the children. Here we pause to recite the Holy Rosary. We will also drive to nearby Aljustrel for a visit to the House of Lucia and the House of Francisco and Jacinta. In the afternoon we return to Fatima for a visit to the Shrine and Basilica of Our Lady, where we will celebrate Mass. Following Mass, we enjoy free

time to explore the sanctuary's grounds. This evening following dinner, we have another opportunity to join the Candlelight Procession. Overnight in Fatima.

October 1, 2026 - Thursday FATIMA / PORTO / SANTIAGO de COMPOSTELA

Today we depart Fatima for Santiago de Compostela, the home of Saint James. En route we will stop at the coastal town of Porto, where upon our arrival we will visit Porto's magnificent Cathedral of the Assumption of Our Lady, followed by free time for lunch. Later in the afternoon, we arrive in Santiago and enjoy a walking tour of the historical center of Santiago, including a visit and celebration of Mass in the Cathedral of St. James the Apostle, housing the remains of the saint. The cathedral's facades display examples of both Romanesque and Baroque architecture. Dinner and overnight in Santiago de Compostela.

October 2, 2026 - Friday SANTIAGO de COMPOSTELA / AVILA

This morning we bid farewell to Santiago and enjoy our drive to Avila, Spain, perhaps the best-preserved walled city in the world and home of Saint Teresa of Avila who with her spiritual director Saint John of the Cross, reformed the Carmelite Order. We celebrate Mass at the Carmelite Monastery of the Incarnation, where we will also see the cell where St. Teresa lived. From here we arrive inside the ancient walls of Avila and visit the Church of St. Teresa where we will see relics of St. Teresa. Dinner and overnight in Avila.

October 3, 2026 - Saturday AVILA / LOYOLA / SAN SEBASTIAN

Today we depart for the town of Loyola, the home of Saint Ignatius, who founded the Society of Jesus in 1540. Upon our arrival we will visit the Basilica of St. Ignatius, followed by a drive to nearby Azpeitia where we will visit the Sanctuary of St. Ignatius, where St. Ignatius was baptized. We continue onto the seaside town of San Sebastian to walk and explore the streets and shops in Old Town, where we see the beautiful city hall building situated across from the beautiful Bay of Biscay. Dinner and overnight in San Sebastian.

October 4, 2026 - Sunday SAN SEBASTIAN / LOURDES

This morning we will visit and celebrate Mass at the Cathedral of the Good Shepherd. Following Mass, we drive to Lourdes, where in 1858, Mary appeared to a young Bernadette Soubirous. Upon our arrival in Lourdes, we enjoy an introduction to the shrine prior to arriving at our hotel for check-in followed by dinner. Following dinner, we participate in the evening's Candlelight Procession. Overnight in Lourdes.

October 5, 2026 - Monday LOURDES

Our day begins with a celebration of Mass in the Basilica of the Immaculate Conception (Upper Basilica). Following Mass, we enjoy a walking tour of Lourdes where we visit the places important in the life of Bernadette, including the Grotto and Spring where Mary appeared to Bernadette numerous times. We see the nearby Healing Baths where many pilgrims submerge themselves for its healing properties. We also visit the Basilica of the Immaculate Conception (Upper Basilica) and the Rosary Basilica (Lower Basilica) as well as the Basilica of Pius X, followed by a visit to Bernadette's home and the Museum of Lourdes. Our afternoon is free for personal exploration of Lourdes, allowing for time for those who wish to visit the Healing Baths. This evening offers another opportunity to participate in the Candlelight Procession. Overnight in Lourdes.

October 6, 2026 - Tuesday LOURDES / BARCELONA

Early this morning we celebrate Mass in the Grotto. Following Mass, we bid farewell to Lourdes and drive to Barcelona, where upon our arrival we enjoy a motor coach tour of this cosmopolitan city, including a visit to its impressive Basilica of the Sagrada Familia, one of the largest churches in Europe. Here we will learn of the history of the basilica, including its initial ground-breaking in 1882 and its construction which became the life's work of Antoni Gaudi until his death in 1926, and continues to this day. We arrive at our hotel for dinner and overnight in Barcelona.

October 7, 2026 - Wednesday BARCELONA / MONTSERRAT / MANRESA

This morning we embark on an excursion to the wonderful mountaintop Sanctuary of Montserrat and enjoy some of the most incredible scenery in Spain. Upon our arrival we enjoy a tour of the Monastery and its grounds, including a visit to the Shrine and see the Statue of Our Lady of Montserrat or Black Madonna, probably Spain's most fervent devotion to the Blessed Mother. Following Mass in the Chapel of the Virgin, we enjoy free time for lunch. Later in the afternoon, we drive to the town of Manresa along the River Cardoner. It is here that Saint Ignatius of Loyola, founder of the Jesuits, or Society of Jesus, spent some 10 months in prayer and meditation and where Saint Ignatius saw a vision and went on to write the "Spiritual Exercises". Here we will visit the Cave of Saint Michael. We return to Barcelona and arrive for a walking tour of its Gothic Quarter and stroll along the famous Las Ramblas Boulevard, one of the most upbeat and striking boulevards in all of Europe. Here we will enjoy free time for shopping and personal exploration of this vibrant city. This evening, we gather for a flamenco dance performance and our "farewell dinner". Overnight in Barcelona.

October 8, 2026 - Thursday BARCELONA / NEW YORK

Following breakfast, we transfer to the airport for our return flight home. Though our pilgrimage draws to a close, its blessings will last a lifetime and its graces are certain to draw us closer to the Lord.
